Voting Machine Acquisition and Allocation Report

On August 13, 2008 the Ohio Secretary of State issued Directive 2008-64 requiring all county boards to issue a report prior to the 15th day before each election that reflected the acquisition and allocation of voting machines.

Wood County currently owns 631 DRE units and four (4) optical scanners. The Board is currently paying on software licenses for 542 DRE units and as such may only utilize a maximum of 542 units keeping 89 in reserve for replacing out non-functioning units. The Board will utilize 3 (3) DRE units for absentee voting at the office. Six (6) DRE units will be used for uploading race results on Election night. The board will also be utilizing four (4) optical scanners for counting absentee paper ballots, at-polls paper ballots and uploading of results on Election Day.
