I. 9:18 a.m. -- Reading of minutes from preceding meeting

Commissioner Herringshaw called the meeting to order and requested reading of the prior meeting minutes. Administrator Andrew Kalmar, Assistant Administrator Carri Stanley, Acting Clerk Janese Diem were also present, along with Chief Dog Warden Andrew Snyder and Bowling Green resident Bruce Jeffers.

There were no out of state travel requests submitted. The personnel actions submitted included intermittent appointments for 2020 for Business Managers Vicki Adams and Patrick Downes, and Project Manager Maricarol Torsok-Hrabovsky. The resignation of Protective Services Worker 3 Heidi Strobel was also submitted along with a request to post the vacant full time position.

Commissioner LaHote moved to approve the resolutions on the attached listing. Commissioner Bowlus seconded the motion. All voted aye and the motion carried.

III. -- Staff Reports

A brief discussion was held regarding the upcoming Employee Recognition Program. An update for the 35 year award was proposed. Administrator Kalmar noted that other options are being considered that would utilize courthouse stone remnants as well as the tree that was removed from the front lawn, but will not be available in time for this year’s program.

Wood County Dog Shelter Quarterly Update (9:30 a.m.) – Mr. Snyder provided the attached information which was referenced throughout the discussion. Included in the discussions was a financial history of the Dog Park. Mr. Snyder noted that Dog Park membership funds may be available to reimburse the general fund for some of the recent Dog Park upgrades. He commented on discussions with Building and Grounds staff on increasing the size of one or two kennels to accommodate larger dogs. Mr. Snyder also noted that a recommendation to adjust shelter hours

the fees associated with them as many individuals often choose the Shelter over higher cost veterinarian services for dogs with behavioral or health issues. The meeting concluded at 10:00 a.m. Mr. Snyder exited at this time.

Mr. Kalmar reminded the Commissioners of the vacancy on the Historical Society Board. Commissioner Herringshaw recommended reaching out to Gordon Bowman as he has expressed interest in other boards and has an application on file. Commissioner Herringshaw also noted the opening on the Planning Commission. Mrs. Stanley will place a few calls to see if an interested individual can be located.

Mr. Kalmar stated that he will be sending draft letters regarding the 2020 appropriations for the Commissioners' review prior to Thursday.

IV. -- Open Forum Citizens Comments/Concerns

Mr. Jeffers noted that the City's decision to transfer curbside recycling to another vendor will mean the likely loss of jobs for some Work Leads to Independence employees.

Commissioner Herringshaw moved to adjourn and Commissioner Bowlus seconded the motion. All voted aye and the motion carried at 10:08 a.m.
