Issue 1	Proposed Constitutional Amendment – To provide for earlier filing deadlines for statewide ballot issues
Issue 2	Proposed Constitutional Amendment – To authorize the state to issue bonds to continue the Clean Ohio program for environmental revitalization and conservation
Issue 3	Proposed Constitutional Amendment – To amend the Constitution to protect private property rights in ground water, lakes and other water courses
Issue 4	Issue withdrawn
Issue 5	Referendum – Referendum on legislation making changes to check cashing lending, sometimes known as “payday lending,” fees, interest rates and practices
Issue 6	Proposed Constitutional Amendment – To amend the Constitution by initiative petition for a casino near Wilmington in southwest Ohio and distribute to all Ohio counties a tax on the casino
