Voting Machine Acquisition and Allocation Report

On August 13, 2008 the Ohio Secretary of State issued Directive 2008-64 requiring all county boards to issue a report prior to the 15th day before each election that reflected the acquisition and allocation of voting machines.

Wood County currently owns 525 ICX units and two (2) optical scanners. The Board is currently paying on software licenses for 525 ICX units and as such may only utilize a maximum of 525 units keeping in reserve for replacing out non-functioning units. The Board will utilize ten (10) **ICX** units for absentee voting at the office. There will be two-hundred-fifty-four (254) machines used in the current election. This leaves two-hundred sixty-one (261) **ICX** units in reserve for deployment to augment units at high traffic precincts. The board will also be utilizing two (2) high-speed optical scanners for counting absentee paper ballots, at-polls paper ballots and uploading of results on Election Day.
