

*Hi again everyone:*

*As you are aware, the Wood County Juvenile Court is implementing an electronic filing system for its custody, visitation, support, and paternity cases.*

*We are now continuing with the attorney registration process.*

*The brief attorney registration process can be completed by linking to the court's public access website at*

*<https://pub.clerkofcourt.co.wood.oh.us/eservicesJUV/login.page>. Once logged in to the court's public access page, follow the link on the left side of the page referencing the Juvenile Portal eFile Registration.*

*As of May 20, 2019, registration will be required of all attorneys who will be counsel of record in custody, visitation, support and paternity cases at the Juvenile Court. All attorneys who are counsel of record in custody, visitation, support and paternity cases must use the electronic filing system. Once you have submitted your registration, it will be held pending for a period of time. After that, you will receive an email indicating you have been successfully registered.*

*Written instructions for our electronic filing system can be found at our website by clicking the public access link and accessing the written instructions for eFiling link on the left side of the page. A video training will also be made available to view at any time. The link to this video training will be posted on our website in the days to come. Finally, there will be a live web based training session on May 20, 2019 at noon. A link to the training session will be posted in the What's New portion of the Juvenile Court's website.*

*Our electronic filing local rule was placed for comment through April 22, 2019. The local rule has now been adopted and is posted on our website. An accompanying administrative order has also been issued and is posted on our website.*
